Although most work is performed inside of an office and production plant, some outside work activities are also required which are subject to seasonal Midwest weather conditions (summer heat and winter cold) dirt, dust, oils and equipment noise. Some travel may occur requiring a valid operator's license and good driving record. Position also requires high levels of personal integrity and initiative.
